Kindergarten – 4th Grade Dress Code

Dress Code – (K – 4th)

ALL BOYS UNIFORM

The following items must follow dress code policy:

- Collared Polo Shirt, Short or Long Sleeve, Hemmed Cuff, without SCA Logo
Colors: Red, Navy, Light Blue
- Collared Polo Shirt, Short or Long Sleeve, Hemmed Cuff, with SCA Logo
Colors: Red, Navy, Light Blue & Black
(This item must be purchased from SCA)
- Navy or Khaki, Uniform Style* Pants or Shorts
Shorts may not be worn on Chapel day
- Belt, Black/Brown/Navy

DRESS AND GROOMING FOR YOUNG MEN

- All pants must be worn at the waistline and must fit appropriately at the inseam and seat area.
- All shirts must be tucked in and buttoned. When worn over the top of a T-shirt, shirts must be tucked in and buttoned to the second button. No jackets or other garments may be tied around the waist.
- Suspenders and/or shoulder straps are to remain on the shoulder. No under garments should be visible.
- Young men must be clean-shaven at all times.
- Earrings or other facial jewelry is prohibited.
- Haircuts should be conservative, neatly trimmed and well groomed. Hair must be cut above the collar, above the ears, and above the eyebrows. Hair must not be bushy or shaggy or long enough to curl up in the back to avoid the collar.
- Length of hair spikes should be no longer than an inch and a half.
- Young men must wear socks and full shoes. Tennis shoes are permissible.
- Clothing with logos or writing, other than SCA, is not permitted.
- Undershirts/tanks must be white when worn under polo shirts.

ALL GIRLS UNIFORM

The following items must follow dress code policy:

- Collared Polo Shirt, Short or Long Sleeve, Hemmed Cuff, without SCA Logo
Colors: Red, Navy, Light Blue
- Collared Polo Shirt, Short or Long Sleeve, Hemmed Cuff, with SCA Logo
Colors: Red, Navy, Light Blue & Black
(This item must be purchased from SCA)
- Navy or Khaki, Uniform Style* Pants or Shorts
Shorts may not be worn on Chapel day
- Navy or Khaki Skirt or Skort, Uniform Style*
Skirt or Skort must touch front and back of knee
- Belt, Black/Brown/Navy

DRESS & GROOMING FOR YOUNG LADIES

- All pants must be worn at the waistline and must fit appropriately at the inseam and seat area.
- Skirts and skorts are not to be shorter than the kneecap and be neat in appearance.
- Straight slits, over-lapping slits and wrap around skirts or skorts are to be pinned. Slits must not part above the knee. No jackets or other garments may be tied around the waist.
- Shirts must be tucked in and buttoned, except the top button. No mid-drift or tight fitting clothes are acceptable.
- All shirts must have sleeves.
- Reasonable earrings are acceptable for young ladies. However, other facial jewelry is not acceptable.
- No unusual and/or distracting hairstyles, hair colors, lipsticks, or nail polishes are acceptable.
- Young ladies may wear closed toe shoes or sandals with back strap. Heels and flip-flops present a health hazard and are not permitted.
- Clothing with logos or writing, other than SCA, is not permitted.
- Undershirts/tanks must be white when worn under polo shirts.

FOR ALL K – 4th GRADE STUDENTS

ALL OUTERWEAR (May be worn in classroom)

The following items do not have to be purchased from SCA; however, they must follow dress code policy:

- Any Style/Color Jacket

MISCELLANEOUS

- Field trip and special day dress code guidelines will be provided by the Administrative staff.
- Students may wear any style/color jacket while inside or outside the classroom; however no inappropriate writing or pictures may appear on the jacket.
- Uniform Style pants and skirts should have no patterns and should not be made of jean, denim, stretch, or corduroy material. Belts must be worn when pants and shorts have belt loops. Pants, shorts, and skirts are not to be worn below the hips or sagging; they should be worn at waist. Shirts must be tucked in throughout the day, no exceptions.
- No cleats are to be worn in the school buildings, on the playground or playground equipment.
- The wearing of hats is not permitted on campus.
- Any previously purchased yellow SCA monogrammed shirts may be worn.
- The administration also reserves the right to make judgment calls on all issues of dress code and grooming.
- Dress code violations will result in disciplinary action.
- SCA adheres to a uniform-style clothing dress code, which is given to parents and students upon enrollment.
- Students may earn dress down days throughout the year; the dress code must be adhered to even though uniforms are not required to be worn.
